His 1978 book *Manias, Panics, and Crashes*, about speculative stock market bubbles, was reprinted in 2000 after the dot-com bubble. He is well known for hegemonic stability theory. He has been referred to as "the master of the genre" on financial crisis by *The Economist*.
