Organic architecture strives to unify space, to blend interiors and exteriors, and create a harmonic built environment not separate or dominant from nature but as a unified whole. Frank Lloyd Wright's own homes, Taliesin in Spring Green, Wisconsin and Taliesin West in Arizona, exemplify the architect's theories of organic architecture and lifestyle

History. The term "organic architecture" was coined by Frank Lloyd Wright (1867-1959), though never well-articulated by his cryptic style of writing: "So here I stand before you preaching organic architecture: declaring organic architecture to be the modern ideal and the teaching so much needed if we are to see the whole of life, and to now serve the whole of life, holding no traditions ...
