The Lawrence family name was found in the USA, the UK, Canada, and Scotland between 1840 and 1920. The most Lawrence families were found in the USA in 1880. In 1840 there were 539 Lawrence families living in New York. This was about 27% of all the recorded Lawrence's in the USA. New York had the highest population of Lawrence families in 1840.
