In 1776 Thomas Paine and Thomas Jefferson were in Philadelphia and each made his most notable contribution to the American Revolution—Paine publishing *Common Sense* and Jefferson drafting the Declaration of Independence.¹ As a consequence of these activities, Paine and Jefferson are, perhaps, more closely associated with the colonies' decision to declare independence than any other figures.

Thomas Paine. Before leaving Washington, he wrote a brief note to Jefferson accusing him of “shyness” in the face of the political opposition. Jefferson quickly denied this charge, and he and Paine continued to correspond. Paine openly supported Jefferson in the presidential election of 1804, though the benefits of his endorsement were questionable.
